

CERTIFICATE ADOPTING PARK RULES

I, the undersigned officer of the Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 17, hereby certify as follows:

1. The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 17 convened in regular session on the 24th day of July, 2007, at the regular meeting place outside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the duly constituted officers and members of the Board, to-wit:

and all of said persons were present, except Director Von Tungeln, thus constituting a quorum. Whereupon, among other business, the following was transacted at the meeting: a written

PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

was introduced for the consideration of the Board. It was then duly moved and seconded that the Park Rules be adopted; and, after due discussion, the motion, carrying with it the adoption of the Park Rules, prevailed and carried unanimously.

That a true, full and correct copy of the aforesaid Park Rules adopted at the meeting described in the above and foregoing paragraph is attached to and follows this certificate; that the Park Rules has been duly recorded in the Board's minutes of the meeting; that the persons named in the above and foregoing paragraph are the duly chosen, qualified and acting officers and members of the Board as indicated therein; that each of the officers and members of the Board was duly and sufficiently notified officially and personally, in advance, of the time, place and purpose of the aforesaid meeting, and that the Park Rules would be introduced and considered for adoption at the meeting, and each of the officers and members consented, in advance, to the holding of the meeting for such purpose; that the meeting was open to the public as required by law; and that public notice of the time, place and subject of the meeting was given as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, and Section 49.063, Texas Water Code.

DISTRICT LAKES & PARKS
GENERAL USE GUIDELINES AND RULES

Within the limits of any of the Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 17 (the "District") recreational facilities, it shall be unlawful for any person to do any of the following acts, except as may be otherwise provided by prior written permission from the District's Board of Directors (the "Board"):

- (a) swimming or wading;
- (b) use motorized vehicles, including motorized boats, other than by authorized lake and park contractors in conducting their work; provided, however, use of remote controlled electric boats less than forty-eight inches in length shall be permitted;
- (c) use the recreational facilities between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.;
- (d) fish or net aquatic life or place traps or trot lines in the water; provided, however, that catch and release fishing is permissible if also permitted by the Telfair Community Association in which the recreational facilities are located;
- (e) harass, kill or catch fowl, waterfowl or other wildlife; feeding of wildlife is highly discouraged because of the detrimental impact to the wildlife and the environment;
- (f) construct floating decks, docks, or other structures that extend into the recreational facilities, except those that are authorized and approved by the District and the Telfair Community Association in which the proposed structure is to be located;
- (g) construct, fill or dredge within the boundaries of the Facilities, except as specifically authorized and approved by the District and the Telfair Community Association in connection with item (f), above.
- (h) carry or discharge any firecrackers, rockets, torpedoes, other fireworks, air guns, bows, arrows, blowguns, darts or slingshots;
- (i) carry any firearms, except those persons duly authorized and licensed by the State of Texas to carry a concealed handgun in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Concealed Handgun Act;
- (j) discharge any firearm;
- (k) hitch, fasten, lead, drive or let loose any kind of animal or fowl; provided that this shall not apply to dogs or house cats when led by cord or chain not more than six feet long;
- (l) leave animal waste;

- (m) damage, cut, break, injure, deface, graffiti, vandalize or disturb any tree, shrub, plant, rock, monument, fence, bench, picnic table or other structure, apparatus or property;
- (n) cut or remove any wood, turf, grass, soil, rock, sand, gravel, landscape material or fertilizer, except as specifically authorized and approved by the District and the Telfair Community Association in connection with item (f), above.
- (o) bring in and or dispose of outside garbage;
- (p) leave garbage, cans, bottles, papers or other refuse within the recreational facilities in places other than in trash receptacles provided therefore;
- (q) burning of any kind;
- (r) carry and/or consume alcoholic beverages of any type; except during any event sponsored by the Telfair Community Association or Telfair Community Counsel and approved by the District where alcoholic beverages are allowed;
- (s) sell or offer for sale any food, drinks, confections, merchandise or services; except during any event sponsored by the Telfair Community Association or Telfair Community Counsel and approved by the District or if such person has a written agreement or permit issued by the District;
- (t) camp overnight;
- (u) play or bet at or against any game that is played, conducted, dealt or carried on with cards, dice or other device, for money, chips, shells, credit or any other representative of value, or maintaining or exhibiting any gambling table or other instrument of gambling or gaming;
- (v) use any threatening, abusive or insulting language or language otherwise constituting "fighting words";
- (w) commit any obscene, lewd or indecent act or creating a nuisance of any kind;
- (x) disturb in any manner any picnic, meeting, service, concert, exercise or exhibition;
- (y) distribute, post, place or erect any advertising, handbill, circular, bill, notice, paper or other advertising device; and
- (z) practice, carry on, conduct or solicit for any trade, occupation, business or profession.

Any person, corporation or other entity violating these guidelines and rules may be subject to a fine of up to \$5,000 per violation or criminal penalties, including imprisonment, or both.
